Jesus never asked us to carry His cross but He does ask us to bear ours. Matter of fact he said those words to his disciples in Matthew 16:24, *"If anyone wishes to come after Me, he must deny himself, and take up his cross and follow Me."* Don Loftis said, "Sometimes, while minding our own business, our discipleship will require us to bear a cross of adversity, persecution, rejection, or even sacrifice."

Paul challenged his readers in Galatians 6:2 when he said, *"Bear one another's burdens, and thereby fulfill the law of Christ."* When you stop to help others that means entering a zone of the unknown for many of us.
