## WHO HAS THE RIGHT OF WAY?

We are all familiar with the triangular-shaped road sign that states “YIELD” in all capital letters. The message on this orange sign is for drivers to allow approaching traffic to have the right of way and to go first.

Back in September of 1986 a Russian ocean liner with over 1200 people on board was moving through the Black Sea while a freighter transporting oats was crossing the same water. For nearly 45 minutes the two captains were aware that they were on a collision course, but neither ordered a change of course until it was too late. The freighter broadsided the ocean liner leading to the sinking of the ship and the loss of 398 lives. Both captains were arrested for their stubborn refusal to yield.

The same mentality brings conflict into our everyday relationships. When husbands and wives refuse to compromise and work toward common goals, then they continue to damage their relationships. Stubbornness also affects company executives, politicians, teammates, and even church leaders. Yes, elders and ministers can operate full speed ahead, but in directions that are neither compatible nor constructive. The dangers associated with all of these choices are obviously dangerous.

Don Loftis said, “Our greatest danger of stubbornness lies in our refusal to bend to the will of God. The Psalmist warned in chapter 78 and verse 8, *“And not be like their fathers, a stubborn and rebellious generation, a generation that did not prepare its heart and whose spirit was not faithful to God.”* Let’s remember, when God says to move, then it’s time to move.”


